Frequently Asked Questions:

Who can come to Awana?

Anyone! Awana is a nondenominational children's ministry dedicated to reaching boys and girls with the Gospel of Christ and training them to serve Him.

Do we have to attend Ellensburg Foursquare Church to join?

No. You and your child can attend any church (or none at all). All are welcome.

How old does my child need to be to start attending?

Your child needs to be 3 years old as of September 1st of the enrollment year. Formal programs go to the 6th grade with independent study options.

My child has a disability, will he/she be welcome?

Of course! We love ALL children.

How do I volunteer?

See our Awana Commander, Mark Manning, or our Awana secretary, Julie Dever. We would love to have you join us. All our volunteers have been through a background check and screening.

It is the middle of the year, can my child still enroll?

Absolutely! Although it is best to sign your child up before the beginning of the school year, we understand that that is not always possible. Your child is welcome at any time.

Can I stay and observe my child?

Yes. Parents are always welcome. Please see Awana Director Mark, or Julie (Secretary) to register your attendance and get a visitor badge.

When do we meet?

We meet from 6:00 to 7:30 pm on Wednesday nights during the school year (check-in is at 6:00 pm)

Where do we meet?

We meet in Ellensburg Foursquare Church. Please enter the building from the East entrance of the church, as the front doors are secured for your child's safety.
